Based on the information these organizations file with the IRS annually on their 990 tax return, she has made a few changes. This administration will only be endorsing charities where a **minimum** of 50% of the donations they receive actually go to their cause.

We are no longer allowed to use the FFWC logo on anything. This is a trademark infringement so we will need to remove it from any brochures, signs, etc. and only use the GF WC Unity in Diversity. Would anyone like to volunteer to make sure this gets done for our club?

The Committees or formerly Departments are now called Community Service Programs or CSP's. And at the state level each CSP has 2 chairs – a Partnership Chair and a Collaboration Chair. The difference is; the Partnership Chair deals directly with the charities that GF WC has agreements (partnered) with. And the Collaboration Chair is in charge of any project not involving a partner. The projects must still fall under the focuses (many of them new) set forth by GF WC for each CSP.
